

# CONSERVATION & PRESERVATION NOT A PRIORITY

After WWII, the country as a whole began to move toward environmentalism.



**1962.** Rachel Carson, marine biologist & conservationist, sounds the alarm about over use of pesticides & chemicals in the book, Silent Spring.

Dolores Huerta & Fannie Lou Hammer organized farm labourers into unions. Hamer set up the 1st co-op to purchase farm land & provide for themselves. Huerta mortgaged her house to start the 1st Farm Workers Credit Union.

**1970.** EPA created by the Nixon Administration, with the realization that the Federal Government has a role to play in environmental protection & regulation.


### ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY UNDER THE TRUMP ADMIN






### CO2 EMISSIONS OVER TIME AND BY SOURCE






### STATES ARE PURSUING INDIVIDUAL RENEWABLE TARGETS

### Renewable Portfolio Standard Policies




### 65% OF NEW US CAPACITY IS SOLAR AND WIND
